- 1 AN ACT Relating to higher education; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 28B.10 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that a number of
- 5 students are entering college without the basic skills necessary to
- 6 complete college level courses successfully. The legislature applauds
- 7 institutional efforts to provide remedial and developmental classes for
- 8 these students but finds that since the taxpayers of the state have
- 9 already provided funds to teach students this material during their
- 10 elementary and high school years, no further state subsidy of the
- 11 material should occur when the student attends a four-year institution
- 12 of higher education. The legislature also finds that any credits
- 13 granted for successful completion of remedial courses should not count
- 14 towards graduation.

- 1 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 With one exception, state funds shall not be used for remedial or
- 4 precollege classes offered at four-year institutions of higher
- 5 education. The exception: State funds may be used for precollege
- 6 courses offered to students enrolled in educational opportunity
- 7 programs. Any credit received from precollege classes shall not be
- 8 included in meeting the number of credits necessary to receive a
- 9 baccalaureate degree.
