## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2693

- 1 AN ACT Relating to adjusting pension contribution rates to reflect
- 2 the state actuary's 1990 valuations; amending RCW 41.45.060; adding a
- 3 new section to chapter 41.45 RCW; creating a new section; and providing
- 4 an effective date.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.45 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Beginning September 1, 1992, through June 30, 1993, the basic state
- 9 contribution rate for the law enforcement officers' and fire fighters'
- 10 retirement system, and the basic employer contribution rates for the
- 11 public employees' retirement system, the teachers' retirement system,
- 12 and the Washington state patrol retirement system shall be as follows:
- 13 (1) 7.16% for all members of the public employees' retirement
- 14 system;

- 1 (2) 11.79% for all members of the teachers' retirement system;
- 2 (3) 11.07% for all members of the law enforcement officers' and
- 3 fire fighters' retirement system; and
- 4 (4) 17.16% for all members of the Washington state patrol
- 5 retirement system.
- 6 Sec. 2. RCW 41.45.060 and 1990 c 18 s 1 are each amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 Beginning ((September 1, 1991)) July 1, 1993, the basic state
- 9 contribution rate for the law enforcement officers' and fire fighters'
- 10 retirement system, and the basic employer contribution rates for the
- 11 public employees' retirement system, the teachers' retirement system,
- 12 and the Washington state patrol retirement system shall be as follows:
- 13 (1) ((7.47)) 7.33% for all members of the public employees'
- 14 retirement system;
- (2)  $((\frac{12.60}{12.60}))$   $\frac{12.23}{12.23}$  for all members of the teachers' retirement
- 16 system;
- 17 (3)  $((\frac{16.44}{}))$  14.00% for all members of the law enforcement
- 18 officers' and fire fighters' retirement system; and
- 19 (4)  $((\frac{15.53}{)})$   $\frac{16.27}{}$  for all members of the Washington state patrol
- 20 retirement system.
- 21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The office of the state actuary shall
- 22 submit a preliminary report to the house of representatives committee
- 23 on appropriations and the senate committee on ways and means by
- 24 December 1, 1992, on the fiscal impact to the state and local
- 25 governments of adjusting the employer contribution rates under section
- 26 1 of this act as compared to the fiscal impact estimated in the
- 27 supplemental biennial operating appropriations act. The office of the

- 1 state actuary shall submit a final report on the fiscal impact of this
- 2 act by December 1, 1993.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act shall take effect September
- 4 1, 1992.
