1 AN ACT Relating to making appropriations for the Tri-Cities Trade, 2 Recreation and Agriculture Center; creating a new section; and making 3 an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that there is a 6 need for agricultural exhibit and recreational space in the Tri-Cities 7 area and that the economic development studies conducted for such facilities show an economic benefit to the state. The Tri-Cities 8 Trade, Recreation and Agriculture Center would provide an indoor arena 9 10 for state and national agricultural and trade exhibits, competitions, 11 and public events. Outdoor space will include needed recreational 12 softball and soccer fields and a fully developed recreational vehicle Recreation and Agriculture Center would be 13 park. The Trade, 14 constructed next to the interstate highway in Pasco to maximize commercial opportunities as a part of the continuing economic
diversification strategy for the Tri-Cities area.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. 3 The sum of six million dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium 4 5 ending June 30, 1993, from the state building construction account to 6 the department of community development for the Tri-Cities Trade, Recreation and Agriculture Center. This appropriation shall be matched 7 8 by at least two million dollars or an equivalent value of land, labor, or materials, provided from nonstate sources for the same purpose as 9 10 this appropriation.
