- AN ACT Relating to railroads; amending RCW 81.48.010; and adding a
- 2 new section to chapter 81.48 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 81.48 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Any county with a population of two hundred ten thousand or more
- 7 that does not adjoin a county with a population of one hundred twenty-
- 8 five thousand or more may adopt ordinances that restrict the ringing of
- 9 bells or sounding of whistles on locomotives where a railway crosses a
- 10 traveled road or street on the same level outside a city if automatic
- 11 grade crossing signals or gates are in place.
- 12 Sec. 2. RCW 81.48.010 and 1961 c 14 s 81.48.010 are each amended
- 13 to read as follows:

Every engineer driving a locomotive on any railway who ((shall 1 2 fail)) fails to ring the bell or sound the whistle upon ((such)) the locomotive, or cause the same to be rung or sounded, at least eighty 3 4 rods from any place where ((such)) the railway crosses a traveled road or street on the same level (except in cities or in counties that enact 5 6 ordinances under section 1 of this act), or to continue the ringing of 7 ((such)) the bell or sounding of ((such)) the whistle until ((such)) the locomotive ((shall have)) has crossed ((such)) the road or street, 8 ((shall be)) is guilty of a misdemeanor. 9
