1 AN ACT Relating to state publications; adding a new section to
2 chapter 40.07 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 44.04 RCW; and
3 adding a new section to chapter 2.56 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 40.07 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 (1) Unless exempted under subsection (2) of this section, every
8 state publication which has as a primary purpose description of the
9 delivery of public services, and not routine administrative functions,
10 shall include information about the sources of funding for the public
11 services described in the publication. The publication shall note
12 whether funding is from a dedicated revenue source or the general fund.
13 If funding is from the general fund, the publication shall identify the

1 general sources of tax support, such as sales tax, business and
2 occupation tax, license fees, or other sources.

3 (2) Upon application by a state agency, the director may exempt the
4 agency from this section. The director shall adopt rules to implement
5 this section.

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 Every publication issued by the legislature which has as a primary
9 purpose description of the delivery of public services by the
10 legislature, and not routine administrative functions, shall include
11 information about the sources of funding for the public services
12 described in the publication. The publication shall note whether
13 funding is from a dedicated revenue source or the general fund. If
14 funding is from the general fund, the publication shall identify the
15 general sources of tax support, such as sales tax, business and
16 occupation tax, license fees, or other sources.

17 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 2.56 RCW
18 to read as follows:

19 Every publication issued by a court which has as a primary purpose
20 description of the delivery of public services by the court, and not
21 routine administrative functions, shall include information about the
22 sources of funding for the public services described in the
23 publication. The publication shall note whether funding is from a
24 dedicated revenue source or the general fund. If funding is from the
25 general fund, the publication shall identify the general sources of tax
26 support, such as sales tax, business and occupation tax, license fees,
27 or other sources.
