- 1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives, the Senate
- 2 concurring, That immediately before adjournment SINE DIE of this 1991
- 3 regular session of the Fifty-second Legislature:
- 4 (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all
- 5 House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, and
- 6 House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by
- 7 the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of such
- 8 measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for third
- 9 reading; and
- 10 (2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all
- 11 Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent resolutions,
- 12 and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed
- 13 by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by the Senate of such
- 14 measures they shall be assigned to the Senate Rules Committee for third
- 15 reading; and
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the
- 17 Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their

- 1 possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE
- 2 of the 1991 regular session of the Fifty-second Legislature, all
- 3 legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent
- 4 resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be in their
- 5 respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and other
- 6 documents pertaining thereto; and
- 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any special
- 8 session of the Fifty-second Legislature shall be numbered as a
- 9 continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the 1991 regular
- 10 session of the Fifty-second Legislature.
