
ENGROSSED HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 4426

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1992 Regular Session

1 WHEREAS, It is of paramount importance to establish cutoff dates
2 for the consideration of legislation during the 1992 Regular Session of
3 the Fifty-Second Legislature;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of
5 the State of Washington, the Senate concurring, That the following
6 cutoff dates shall apply to all bills, memorials, and joint resolutions
7 with the exception of budgets and matters necessary to implement
8 budgets:

9 Friday, February 7, 1992, the twenty-sixth day, shall be the final
10 day to read in committee reports in the house of origin with the
11 exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means, Senate
12 Transportation, and House fiscal committees;

13 Tuesday, February 11, 1992, the thirtieth day, shall be the final
14 day to read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House
15 fiscal committee reports in the house of origin;

1 Tuesday, February 18, 1992, the thirty-seventh day, at 5:00 p.m.,
2 shall be the final time to consider bills in their house of origin;

3 Friday, February 28, 1992, the forty-seventh day, shall be the
4 final day to read in committee reports on bills from the opposite house
5 with the exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means, Senate
6 Transportation, and House fiscal committees;

7 Monday, March 2, 1992, the fiftieth day, shall be the final day to
8 read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House fiscal
9 committee reports on bills from the opposite house; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That after 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 6,
11 1992, the fifty-fourth day, neither house may consider any bills,
12 memorials, or joint resolutions except messages pertaining to
13 amendments, matters of differences between the two houses, conference
14 reports, and matters incident to the interim and to the closing of the
15 business of the 1992 Regular Session of the Legislature.
