- 1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
- 2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:
- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 7 represent and petition as follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, The wild salmon and steelhead resources of the Columbia
- 9 river are in decline, and one stock, the Snake river sockeye salmon,
- 10 has been listed as endangered by National Marine Fisheries Service; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The federally funded Mitchell act hatchery facilities
- 12 existing on the Columbia river and its tributaries may be critical for
- 13 wild stock supplementation; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The federally funded Mitchell act hatchery facilities
- 15 existing on the Columbia river and its tributaries are currently the

- 1 source of almost all commercial salmon harvest from the Columbia river
- 2 system; and
- 3 WHEREAS, These facilities are in a state of disrepair, and require
- 4 Congressional appropriation for ongoing maintenance and capital
- 5 improvements;
- 6 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
- 7 Congress appropriate sufficient funds during the upcoming session to
- 8 adequately fund operations and capital improvements for Mitchell act
- 9 facilities from which hatchery salmon do not negatively impact wild
- 10 salmon stocks in the states of Washington and Oregon.
- 11 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 12 transmitted to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United
- 13 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
- 14 House of Representatives, and to each member of Congress from the State
- 15 of Washington.
