Read first time February 1, 1991. Referred to Committee on Fisheries & Wildlife.

1 AN ACT Relating to salmon labeling for human consumption; adding 2 new sections to chapter 69.04 RCW; creating a new section; and 3 prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 69.04 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in 8 this section apply throughout sections 2 through 4 of this act.

9 (1) "Salmon" means all species of the genus Oncorhynchus, except 10 those classified as game fish in Title 77 RCW, and includes:

5 (2) "Commercially caught" means salmon harvested by commercial6 fishers.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 69.04 RCW
8 to read as follows:

9 No person may label, advertise, or offer for retail sale any fresh 10 or frozen salmon food fish and cultured aquatic salmon without 11 identifying the species of salmon by its common name. Any person 12 violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of misbranding 13 under the provisions of this chapter.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 69.04 RCW 15 to read as follows:

16 No person may label, advertise, or offer for retail sale any fresh 17 or frozen:

(1) Private sector cultured aquatic salmon without identifying theproduct as farm raised salmon; or

(2) Commercially caught salmon designated as food fish under Title
 75 RCW without identifying the product as commercially caught salmon;
 or

(3) Private sector cultured aquatic salmon or commercially caught salmon without identifying the product as "domestic" or "imported," and, if caught or grown in Washington, as "Washington-caught" or "Washington-grown."

Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty
 of misbranding under the provisions of this chapter.

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 69.04 RCW 4 to read as follows:

5 To promote honesty and fair dealing for consumers, the director, in 6 consultation with the director of the department of fisheries, shall 7 promulgate rules:

8 (1) Fixing and establishing a reasonable definition and standard of 9 identity for salmon for purposes of consumer labeling and advertising; 10 and

11 (2) Enforcing the provisions of sections 2 and 3 of this act.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. If specific funding for the purposes of 13 this act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June 14 30, 1991, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act shall be null and 15 void.
