1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, The current Federal Surface Transportation Assistance Act
9 expires September 20, 1991, and the United States Congress must draft
10 a new law to continue Federal-Aid highway programs and the Highway
11 Trust Fund; and

12 WHEREAS, The Washington State Legislature and its members endorse
13 the principles developed by the Highway Users Federation and those of
14 the Washington Transportation Policy Institute;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that Congress
16 act without delay to adopt the new Federal Surface Transportation

1 Assistance Act by October 1, 1991, and include elements of the
2 Federation's plan in Federal Highway legislation.

3 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately sent to
4 the Honorable George Bush, President of the United States, the
5 President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of
6 Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
7 Washington.
