1 AN ACT Relating to exempting property from execution; and adding a 2 new section to chapter 6.15 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 6.15 RCW
to read as follows:

6 Property in this state of a judgment debtor where the judgment is 7 in favor of any other state for failure to pay that state's income tax 8 on benefits received from a pension or other retirement plan shall be 9 exempt from execution, attachment, garnishment, or seizure by or under 10 any legal process whatever, and when a debtor dies, or absconds, and 11 leaves his or her family any money exempted by this section, the same 12 shall be exempt to the family.
