## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5081

- 1 AN ACT Relating to steelhead catch record cards; and amending RCW
- 2 77.32.360.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 77.32.360 and 1990 c 84 s 7 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A steelhead catch record card is required to fish for steelhead
- 7 trout. ((The fee for this catch record card is fifteen dollars.))
- 8 (a) The fee for an annual steelhead catch record card is fifteen
- 9 dollars and the fee for a two-day steelhead catch record card is five
- 10 <u>dollars</u>.
- 11 (b) A two-day steelhead catch record card shall be issued to
- 12 residents and nonresidents. It is valid for two consecutive days
- 13 following the time of issuance. A person may purchase more than one
- 14 two-day card a year. A valid fishing license is required in order to

- 1 obtain a two-day steelhead catch record card. The two-day steelhead
- 2 catch record card is valid for a total catch of four steelhead trout.
- 3 (2) Persons possessing steelhead trout shall immediately validate
- 4 their <u>annual steelhead</u> catch record card <u>or two-day steelhead catch</u>
- 5 <u>record card</u> as provided by rule.
- 6 (3) The <u>annual</u> steelhead catch record card required under this
- 7 section expires April 30th following the date of issuance.
- 8 (4) Each person who returns ((a)) an annual steelhead catch record
- 9 card to an authorized license dealer by June 1 following the period for
- 10 which it was issued shall be given a credit equal to five dollars
- 11 towards that day's purchase of any license, permit, transport tag,
- 12 catch record card, or stamp required by this chapter. This subsection
- 13 does not apply to annual steelhead catch record cards for persons under
- 14 the age of fifteen.
- 15 (5) Persons under the age of fifteen may purchase an annual
- 16 steelhead catch record card for five dollars. The five-dollar catch
- 17 record card for persons under the age of fifteen entitles the holder to
- 18 retain no more than five steelhead. After retaining five steelhead, a
- 19 new catch record card may be purchased.
