1 AN ACT Relating to compensation for jurors; and amending RCW 2 2.36.150.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 2.36.150 and 1987 c 202 s 105 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

Jurors shall receive for each day's attendance, besides mileage at the rate determined under RCW 43.03.060, ((the following)) compensation((÷

9 (1) Grand jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no 10 case less than ten dollars;

11 (2) Petit jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no
12 case less than ten dollars;

13 (3) Coroner's jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in 14 no case less than ten dollars;

(4) District court jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but 1 2 in no case less than ten dollars: PROVIDED, That)) at not less than the state minimum wage. A person excused from jury service at his or 3 4 her own request shall be allowed not more than a per diem and such mileage, if any, as to the court shall seem just and equitable under 5 all circumstances((: PROVIDED FURTHER, That)). The state shall fully 6 reimburse the county in which trial is held for all jury fees and 7 witness fees related to criminal cases which result from incidents 8 occurring within an adult or juvenile correctional institution((+ 9 PROVIDED FURTHER, That)). The compensation paid jurors shall be 10 11 determined by the county legislative authority and shall be uniformly applied within the county. 12
