## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5118

- 1 AN ACT Relating to a fisheries hotline; and adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 75.12 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 75.12 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The department shall contract with the department of wildlife to
- 7 use their state-wide twenty-four-hour toll-free hotline for reporting
- 8 of food fish law violations. Upon receipt of a hotline report of an
- 9 in-progress violation the department shall make a good faith effort to
- 10 immediately respond.
- 11 The department shall contact each person who calls and identifies
- 12 himself or herself on the type of action that was taken and the results
- 13 of the investigation.
- 14 The department shall work with the department of wildlife to
- 15 publicize the state-wide twenty-four-hour toll-free hotline for

- 1 reporting of food fish law violations. The departments shall take
- 2 steps to assure that the food fish and shellfish poaching hotline
- 3 number is listed in phone books throughout the state, is included in
- 4 both agencies' regulation information pamphlets, and that all other law
- 5 enforcement entities in the state are informed of the program.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 7 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 8 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 9 effect immediately.
