- 1 AN ACT Relating to candidate residency requirements; and adding new
- 2 sections to chapter 29.30 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 29.30 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Election officers shall review filings to determine that candidates
- 7 are registered to vote in the district for which they file. No
- 8 candidate's name may be placed on a ballot if the county elections
- 9 officer or the secretary of state finds the candidate is not registered
- 10 to vote within the geographic area required in order to assume the
- 11 office if elected.
- 12 This section does not apply to candidates for the United States
- 13 senate and United States house of representatives.

- 1 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 29.30 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 Each county, municipal corporation, or special district shall
- 4 provide to the appropriate election officer the most current
- 5 information describing its geographical boundaries and the geographical
- 6 boundaries of its director, council, or commissioner districts.
