- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 9A.36.100 and 1988 c 151 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A person is guilty of custodial assault if that person is not
- 7 guilty of an assault in the first or second degree and where the
- 8 person:
- 9 (a) Assaults a full or part-time staff member or volunteer, any
- 10 educational personnel, any personal service provider, or any vendor or
- 11 agent thereof at any juvenile corrections institution or local juvenile
- 12 detention facilities who was performing official duties at the time of
- 13 the assault;
- 14 (b) Assaults a full or part-time staff member or volunteer, any
- 15 educational personnel, any personal service provider, or any vendor or

- 1 agent thereof at any adult corrections institution or local adult
- 2 detention facilities who was performing official duties at the time of
- 3 the assault;
- 4 (c)(i) Assaults a full or part-time community correction officer
- 5 while the officer is performing official duties; or
- 6 (ii) Assaults any other full or part-time employee who is employed
- 7 in a community corrections office while the employee is performing
- 8 official duties; ((or))
- 9 (d) Assaults a full or part-time staff member or volunteer, any
- 10 <u>educational personnel</u>, any personal service provider, or any vendor or
- 11 vendor's agent at any state hospital for the mentally ill who was
- 12 performing official duties at the time of the assault; or
- 13 (e) Assaults any volunteer who was assisting a person described in
- 14 (c) of this subsection at the time of the assault.
- 15 (2) Custodial assault is a class C felony.
