## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5225

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to environmental interpretation in Washington's 2 state parks; and adding new sections to chapter 43.51 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that the lands owned 4 5 and managed by the state parks and recreation commission are a 6 significant collection of valuable natural, historical, and cultural resources for the citizens of Washington state. The legislature 7 further finds that if citizens understand and appreciate the state park 8 9 ecological resources, they will come to appreciate and understand the 10 ecosystems and natural resources throughout the state. Therefore, the state parks and recreation commission may increase the use of its 11 12 facilities and resources to provide environmental interpretation 13 throughout the state parks system.

1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. The state parks and recreation commission
2 may provide environmental interpretative activities for visitors to
3 state parks that:

4 (1) Explain the functions, history, and cultural aspects of5 ecosystems;

6 (2) Explain the relationship between human behaviors and attitudes7 and the environment; and

8 (3) Offer experiences and information to increase citizen9 appreciation and stewardship of the environment.

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. The state parks and recreation commission 11 may consult and enter into agreements with and solicit assistance from 12 private sector organizations and other governmental agencies that are 13 interested in conserving and interpreting Washington's environment.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. Sections 1 through 3 of this act are each 15 added to chapter 43.51 RCW.
