1 AN ACT Relating to communication with a minor for immoral purposes; 2 and amending RCW 9.68A.090.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 9.68A.090 and 1989 c 32 s 7 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 <u>A person is guilty of communication with a minor for immoral</u> 7 purposes if the person commands, solicits, encourages, requests, or 8 propositions any minor to commit an act with the person or anyone else 9 when the act would be a criminal sex offense under either Title 9 or 9A 10 RCW.

A person who communicates with a minor for immoral purposes is guilty of a gross misdemeanor, unless that person has previously been convicted under this section or of a felony sexual offense under chapter 9.68A, 9A.44, or 9A.64 RCW or of any other felony sexual offense in this or any other state, in which case the person is guilty 1 of a class C felony punishable under chapter 9A.20 RCW.
