- 1 AN ACT Relating to tuition waivers for public school employees; and
- 2 amending RCW 28B.15.558.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 28B.15.558 and 1990 c 88 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The governing boards of state institutions of higher education
- 7 as defined in RCW 28B.10.016 may waive the tuition and services and
- 8 activities fees for state employees as defined under subsection (2) of
- 9 this section pursuant to the following conditions:
- 10 (a) Such state employees shall register for and be enrolled in
- 11 courses on a space available basis and no new course sections shall be
- 12 created as a result of the registration;
- 13 (b) Enrollment information on state employees registered pursuant
- 14 to this section shall be maintained separately from other enrollment
- 15 information and shall not be included in official enrollment reports,

- 1 nor shall such state employees be considered in any enrollment
- 2 statistics which would affect budgetary determinations; and
- 3 (c) State employees registering on a space available basis shall be
- 4 charged a registration fee of not less than five dollars.
- 5 (2) For the purposes of this section, "state employees" means
- 6 permanent full-time employees in classified service under chapters
- 7 28B.16 and 41.06 RCW and employees of public school districts.
