## SENATE BILL 5462

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to modification of the Northwest interstate compact 2 on low-level radioactive waste management; and amending RCW 43.145.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 43.145.020 and 1990 c 21 s 5 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 The person designated as the Washington representative to the 7 committee as specified in Article V shall adhere to all provisions of the low-level radioactive waste compact. 8 In considering special conditions or arrangements for access to the state's facilities from 9 10 wastes generated outside of the region, the committee member shall 11 ensure at a minimum, that the provisions of Article IV, Section 3 are 12 complied with. After 1992 the Washington representative may approve access to the state's facility only for the states currently members of 13 14 the Rocky Mountain compact or states which generate less than one 15 thousand cubic feet of waste annually and are contiguous with a state

1 which is a member of the Northwest compact. <u>The committee member may</u> 2 <u>not vote affirmatively to accept out-of-region low-level waste at the</u> 3 <u>state's facility unless the compact is modified to prevent in-state</u> 4 <u>generators of low-level waste from using low-level waste facilities</u> 5 <u>outside of the region.</u>
