1 AN ACT Relating to residential habilitation centers; and amending
2 RCW 71A.20.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 71A.20.020 and 1988 c 176 s 702 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 The following residential habilitation centers are permanently
7 established to provide services to persons with developmental
8 disabilities: Interlake School, located at Medical Lake, Spokane
9 county; Lakeland Village, located at Medical Lake, Spokane county;
10 Rainier School, located at Buckley, Pierce county; Yakima Valley
11 School, located at Selah, Yakima county; Fircrest School, located at
12 Seattle, King county; and Frances Haddon Morgan ((Children's)) Center,
13 located at Bremerton, Kitsap county.
