## SENATE BILL 5562

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

By Senators Erwin, Vognild, Thorsness, Nelson and Johnson.

Read first time February 7, 1991. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

- AN ACT Relating to the use of reserved lanes on multilane highways;
- 2 amending RCW 46.61.165; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that high
- 5 occupancy vehicle lanes are currently underutilized. The legislature
- 6 also finds that carpooling will be better encouraged by permitting
- 7 motor vehicles with as few as two occupants to travel in any high
- 8 occupancy vehicle lane.
- 9 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.61.165 and 1984 c 7 s 65 are each amended to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 The state department of transportation and the local authorities
- 12 are authorized to reserve all or any portion of any highway under their
- 13 respective jurisdictions, including any designated lane or ramp, for
- 14 the exclusive or preferential use of public transportation vehicles or

- 1 private motor vehicles carrying no fewer than ((a specified number of
- 2 passengers)) two occupants when such limitation will increase the
- 3 efficient utilization of the highway or will aid in the conservation of
- 4 energy resources. Regulations authorizing such exclusive or
- 5 preferential use of a highway facility may be declared to be effective
- 6 at all times or at specified times of day or on specified days but in
- 7 no event shall such regulations require that designated lanes be
- 8 reserved to vehicles with occupants in excess of two.
