- 2 amending RCW 29.27.072 and 29.27.074.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 29.27.072 and 1967 c 96 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 The secretary of state shall ((cause)) publish notice of the
- 7 proposed constitutional amendments ((and laws authorizing state debts))
- 8 that are to be submitted to the people ((to be published)) at least
- 9 four times during the four weeks ((next)) immediately preceding the
- 10 election in every legal newspaper in the state ((and)). He or she
- 11 shall supplement this publication ((thereof by)) with an equivalent
- 12 <u>amount of</u> radio and television ((broadcast as provided in RCW
- 13 65.16.130, 65.16.140, and 65.16.150)) advertisements.

- 1 Sec. 2. RCW 29.27.074 and 1967 c 96 s 2 are each amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- 3 The <u>newspaper</u> notice provided for in RCW 29.27.072 shall ((set
- 4 forth)) contain the following information:
- 5 (1) ((A)) The legal ((identification)) designation of ((the)) each
- 6 state measure to be voted upon((-)) $\frac{1}{2}$ and
- 7 (2) The official ballot title of ((such)) each state measure.
- 8 (((3) A brief statement explaining the constitutional provision or
- 9 state law as it presently exists.
- 10 (4) A brief statement explaining the effect of the state measure
- 11 should it be approved.
- 12 (5) The total number of votes cast for and against the measure in
- 13 both the state senate and house of representatives.))
