- 1 AN ACT Relating to sterilization and infection control in dentists'
- 2 offices; amending RCW 18.32.725; and adding a new section to chapter
- 3 18.32 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.32.725 and 1935 c 112 s 27 are each amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 It shall be the duty of every person engaged in the practice of
- 8 dentistry or who shall own, operate, or manage any dental office to
- 9 keep said office and dental equipment in a thoroughly clean and
- 10 sanitary condition and to fulfill the requirements for sterilization of
- 11 equipment and infection control adopted by the board under section 2 of
- 12 this act. Failure to comply with the duty established under this
- 13 <u>section is unprofessional conduct</u>.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 18.32 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 The dental disciplinary board shall adopt rules establishing
- 4 minimum requirements for sterilization of equipment and infection
- 5 control in dentists' offices. In adopting the rules, the dental
- 6 disciplinary board shall consider standards established by national
- 7 health associations for sterilization of equipment and infection
- 8 control, including standards adopted for surgical procedures.
