## ENGROSSED SECOND SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5724

- 1 AN ACT Relating to water pollution control of chlorinated organic
- 2 compound emissions; adding a new section to chapter 90.48 RCW; creating
- 3 a new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The legislature finds that
- 6 scientifically valid and technically achievable effluent limitations on
- 7 the pulp and paper industry are necessary for the protection of the
- 8 waters of the state of Washington. The legislature also finds that the
- 9 United States environmental protection agency is in the process of
- 10 developing national effluent guidelines for pulp and paper mills
- 11 limiting discharge of chlorinated organics. In order to conserve
- 12 limited economic resources, the legislature finds that the department
- 13 of ecology should not duplicate ongoing federal efforts.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 90.48 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 The department shall:
- 4 (1) Issue no permit establishing limits for the discharge of
- 5 chlorinated organic compounds by pulp mills and paper mills under RCW
- 6 90.48.160 or 90.48.260 until the United States environmental protection
- 7 agency issues final effluent guidelines; then the department may issue
- 8 permits containing chlorinated organics discharge limitations
- 9 consistent with the national guidelines.
- 10 (2) Nothing in this section shall apply to dioxin compounds.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 12 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 13 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 14 effect immediately.
