- AN ACT Relating to the state environmental policy act; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 43.21C RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature recognizes that land use
- 5 decisions have been delayed because threshold determinations are not
- 6 being completed within a reasonable time, after being postponed for
- 7 months beyond the recommended state agency fifteen-day guideline. The
- 8 effect has been unreasonable and costly delays for land use decisions.
- 9 To correct his problem, the legislature recognizes the need for a
- 10 definite time limit for making threshold determinations.
- 11 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.21C RCW
- 12 to read as follows:

- 1 A threshold determination shall be completed within fifteen days if
- 2 possible, but under no circumstance shall take longer than sixty days
- 3 unless the applicant consents to an extension. If no agency decision
- 4 has occurred after sixty days, a declaration of nonsignificance shall
- 5 automatically be issued, not subject to administrative, legal, or other
- 6 appeals.
