1 AN ACT Relating to registration of architects; and amending RCW 2 18.08.350.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 sec. 1. RCW 18.08.350 and 1985 c 37 s 6 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) A certificate of registration shall be granted by the director 7 to all qualified applicants who are certified by the board as having 8 passed the required examination and as having given satisfactory proof 9 of completion of the required experience.

10 (2) Applications for examination shall be filed as the board 11 prescribes by rule. The application and examination fees shall be 12 determined by the director under RCW 43.24.086.

(3) An applicant for registration as an architect shall be of agood moral character, at least eighteen years of age, and shall:

1 (a) Have an accredited architectural degree and three years' 2 practical architectural work experience approved by the board. At 3 least two years' work experience must be under the direct supervision 4 of an architect; or

5 (b) Have eight years' practical architectural work experience 6 approved by the board. Each year spent in an accredited architectural 7 program approved by the board shall be considered one year of practical 8 experience. At least four years' practical work experience shall be 9 under the direct supervision of an architect; or

10 (c) Be a person who has been designing buildings as a principal activity for eight years, or has an equivalent combination of education 11 and experience, but who was not registered under chapter 323, Laws of 12 1959, as amended, as it existed before July 28, 1985, provided that 13 14 application is made within ((four)) <u>ten</u> years after July 28, 1985. Nothing in this chapter prevents such a person from designing buildings 15 for ((four)) ten years after July 28, 1985, or the five-year period 16 17 allowed for completion of the examination process, after that person 18 has applied for registration. A person who has been designing 19 buildings and is qualified under this subsection shall, upon 20 application to the board of registration for architects, be allowed to take the examination for architect registration on an equal basis with 21 22 other applicants.
