1 AN ACT Relating to automobile insurance; amending RCW 48.18.297; 2 and adding a new section to chapter 48.18 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 48.18.297 and 1969 ex.s. c 241 s 24 are each amended 5 to read as follows:

A private passenger automobile as used in ((RCW 48.18.291 through
7 48.18.297)) this chapter shall mean:

8 (1) An individually owned motor vehicle of the private passenger or 9 station wagon type that is not used as a public or livery conveyance 10 for passengers, nor rented to others.

(2) Any other individually owned four-wheel motor vehicle with a load capacity of fifteen hundred pounds or less which is not used in the occupation, profession, or business of the insured. <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 48.18 RCW
 to read as follows:

No private passenger automobile liability insurer shall refuse to issue a private passenger liability insurance policy or increase the rate to be charged for a policy based on the grounds that the applicant has never purchased a policy or has not purchased or been covered by a policy during a specified time period immediately preceding the date of application.
