## ENGROSSED SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5812

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

Read first time March 11, 1991.

- 1 AN ACT Relating to delinquent property taxes; adding a new section
- 2 to chapter 84.56 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 84.38 RCW; and
- 3 declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 84.56 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 RCW 84.56.020 notwithstanding, if 1991 taxes payable on real
- 8 property exceed one hundred fifty percent of the 1990 taxes payable on
- 9 the property:
- 10 (1) No interest or penalties may be assessed for the period April
- 11 30, 1991, through April 30, 1992, on the amount that the 1991 taxes
- 12 exceed one hundred fifty percent of the 1990 taxes; and
- 13 (2) The provisions of RCW 84.56.020 regarding the payment of taxes
- 14 on the property shall be computed separately for the amount that 1991

- 1 taxes do not exceed one hundred fifty percent of 1990 taxes and for the
- 2 remaining amount.
- 3 This section does not apply to 1991 taxes attributable to increases
- 4 in value due to new construction, improvements to property, or the
- 5 subdivision of land.
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 84.38 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 RCW 84.38.100 notwithstanding, no interest may be assessed for the
- 9 period April 30, 1991, through April 30, 1992, on the amount that 1991
- 10 taxes deferred under this chapter exceed one hundred fifty percent of
- 11 the 1990 taxes on the property.
- 12 This section does not apply to 1991 taxes attributable to increases
- 13 in value due to new construction, improvements to property, or the
- 14 subdivision of land.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 16 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 17 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 18 effect immediately.
