- 1 AN ACT Relating to disposition of new replacement vehicle tire
- 2 fees; and amending RCW 70.95.535.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 70.95.535 and 1989 c 431 s 93 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Every person engaged in making retail sales of new replacement
- 7 vehicle tires in this state shall retain ten percent of the collected
- 8 one dollar fee. The moneys retained may be used for costs associated
- 9 with the proper management of the waste vehicle tires by the retailer.
- 10 (2) The department of ecology will administer the funds for the
- 11 purposes specified in RCW 70.95.020(5) including, but not limited to:
- 12 (a) Making grants to local governments for pilot demonstration
- 13 projects for on-site shredding and recycling of tires from unauthorized
- 14 dump sites;
- (b) Grants to local government for enforcement programs;

- 1 (c) Grants to other state agencies for projects that involve
- 2 recycling of or energy production from waste tires;
- 3 (d) Implementation of a public information and education program to
- 4 include posters, signs, and informational materials to be distributed
- 5 to retail tire sales and tire service outlets;
- 6 $((\frac{d}{d}))$ <u>(e)</u> Product marketing studies for recycled tires and
- 7 alternatives to land disposal.
