- 1 AN ACT Relating to gasoline dispensing device labeling; amending
- 2 RCW 19.94.505; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 19.94.505 and 1984 c 61 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 It is unlawful for any dealer or service station, as both are
- 7 defined in RCW 82.36.010, to sell ((ethanol and/or methanol at one
- 8 percent, by volume, or greater in)) gasoline for use as motor vehicle
- 9 fuel unless the dispensing device has a label stating the type and
- 10 maximum percentage of alcohol contained in the motor vehicle fuel. The
- 11 dispensing device shall also be labeled with the following disclaimer:
- 12 <u>"WARNING GASOLINE CONTAINING ALCOHOL MAY BE UNSUITABLE AS FUEL FOR</u>
- 13 SOME INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES. ENGINE DAMAGE MAY RESULT FROM USE OF
- 14 IMPROPER FUEL. CONSULT ENGINE MANUFACTURER FOR FUEL RECOMMENDATIONS."

1 Violation of this section is a misdemeanor.
