1 AN ACT Relating to tax levies for library improvements; and 2 creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. Tax levies authorized by voter approval 5 of a ballot proposition submitted by a city under RCW 84.55.050 at an election held prior to 1988 for the purpose of funding the cost of 6 7 library improvements, plus the costs of borrowing such amount for up to twenty years, may be levied in the amounts and in the years authorized 8 by the voters in addition to the levies otherwise allowed by this 9 10 chapter until the expiration of the limited period or satisfaction of 11 the limited so authorized, whichever first, purpose comes 12 notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 84.55.050(2). This section is and shall apply retroactively to all 13 curative limited ballot propositions described herein. The elections at which any such ballot 14 15 propositions were submitted, and the tax levies authorized thereby,

shall be valid and effective in all respects. This section shall not
be construed to adversely affect the validity or reduce the amount of
any tax levies authorized by any other ballot proposition heretofore or
hereafter submitted under RCW 84.55.050.
