6 (1) A person is guilty of criminal impersonation if ((he)) the

8 (a) Assumes a false identity and does an act in ((his)) that 9 assumed character with intent to defraud another or for any other 10 unlawful purpose; ((or))

(b) Pretends to be a representative of some person or organization or a public servant and does an act in ((his)) that pretended capacity with intent to defraud another or for any other unlawful purpose; or

- 1 (c) Pretends to be a law enforcement officer and does an act in
- 2 that pretended capacity with intent to harass, intimidate, restrain,
- 3 torment, or embarrass another person.
- 4 (2) Criminal impersonation is a gross misdemeanor.
