- 1 AN ACT Relating to identification of law enforcement vehicles; and
- 2 amending RCW 46.61.210.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 46.61.210 and 1965 ex.s. c 155 s 32 are each amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Upon the immediate approach of an authorized emergency vehicle
- 7 making use of audible and visual signals meeting the requirements of
- 8 RCW 46.37.190, or of ((a police)) an identifiable law enforcement
- 9 vehicle properly and lawfully making use of an audible signal only, the
- 10 driver of every other vehicle shall yield the right of way and shall
- 11 immediately drive to a position parallel to, and as close as possible
- 12 to, the right-hand edge or curb of the roadway clear of any
- 13 intersection and shall stop and remain in such position until the

- 1 authorized emergency or law enforcement vehicle has passed, except when
- 2 otherwise directed by a ((police)) law enforcement officer.
- 3 (2) A driver of a vehicle shall not be cited under this section if
- 4 the law enforcement vehicle is not clearly identifiable as a law
- 5 <u>enforcement vehicle</u>. <u>Identification includes</u>, <u>but is not limited to</u>,
- 6 the official insignia of the law enforcement agency, lettering
- 7 indicating the jurisdiction of the law enforcement vehicle, or the use
- 8 of visual signal devices affixed across the full width of the outside
- 9 of the vehicle.
- 10 (3) This section shall not operate to relieve the driver of an
- 11 authorized emergency vehicle from the duty to drive with due regard for
- 12 the safety of all persons using the highway.
