1 AN ACT Relating to the protection of students in kindergarten 2 through twelfth grades; adding a new section to chapter 9A.84 RCW; and 3 prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 9A.84 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 (1) A person is guilty of interfering with school activities if, 8 while the school is in session and the person is on public premises 9 adjacent to or on the grounds of any public or approved private school 10 under Title 28A RCW, the person:

(a) Makes any noise or diversion that disturbs or tends to disturb the peace or good order of a school session or a class of a school session; or

1 (b) Fails to leave the premises or immediate vicinity of the public 2 or approved private school while the school is in session at the 3 request of a school authority if the person is committing, threatens to 4 commit, or is initiating the commission by another of an act that would 5 disrupt, impair, interfere with, or obstruct the lawful mission, 6 process, procedures, or functions of the public or approved private 7 school.

(2) Interfering with school activities is a misdemeanor.
