## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 6208

AN ACT Relating to a public utility district customer utilizing an electrical contractor; adding a new section to chapter 54.04 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that a customer of 6 a public utility district should have the opportunity to purchase the 7 services of a qualified electrical contractor licensed by the state. 8 The legislature further finds that this opportunity presently exists 9 for customers of a municipal electrical utility and that no legitimate 10 reasons exist to withhold this opportunity from customers of public 11 utility districts that operate an electrical utility.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 54.04 RCW 13 to read as follows:

p. 1 of 2

SSB 6208

If a district engaged in the operation of an electric utility 1 directly assesses its customers a service installation charge for a 2 temporary service, permanent service, or expanded service, the customer 3 may contract with a qualified electrical contractor licensed under 4 chapter 19.28 RCW to install the necessary material or equipment in 5 б lieu of having district personnel perform the installation. If a customer elects to employ a private electrical contractor, the private 7 electrical contractor shall be solely responsible for any damages 8 9 resulting from the installation of any temporary service, permanent service, or expanded service and the district shall be immune from 10 liability for that installation. 11
