- 1 AN ACT Relating to public assistance; commissioning a study by the
- 2 department of social and health services; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The department of social and health
- 5 services shall conduct a planning study of the children in its care to
- 6 determine the appropriate level of residential and treatment services
- 7 required by these children. The study shall be based on a
- 8 statistically valid sample of all children in the department's care.
- 9 The study shall also estimate the treatment needs of youth who have
- 10 been evaluated for a mental disorder but were not involuntarily
- 11 detained pursuant to chapter 71.34 RCW.
- 12 In conducting the study, the department shall utilize all existing
- 13 studies to the extent possible. The department shall report the
- 14 results of the study to the appropriate standing committees of the

- 1 legislature by September 15, 1992. The department shall use the study
- 2 results for designing future programs, treatment models, and for
- 3 determining the reallocation of funds within the department. The
- 4 department shall submit recommendations to the appropriate standing
- 5 committees of the legislature on the necessary reallocation of funds,
- 6 as indicated by the assessment results, by January 1, 1993.
