1 AN ACT Relating to licenses for private detective agencies; and
2 adding a new section to chapter 18.165 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.165 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The fee for a license issued to a private detective agency may
7 not exceed twenty-five dollars if the agency employs fewer than two
8 persons licensed under this chapter in a calendar year.

9 (2) If an agency meets the criteria set forth in subsection (1) of
10 this section, no fee may be charged for a license issued to an
11 individual under RCW 18.165.040 or 18.165.050, as long as: (a) The
12 person is employed by the agency; (b) the person is employed by no
13 other agency; and (c) the agency neither employs, nor regularly
14 contracts with, another person licensed under this chapter.

1 (3) If any of the criteria set forth in subsection (1) or (2) of
2 this section ceases to be met, the remaining provisions of this chapter
3 become applicable immediately.
