1 AN ACT Relating to before-and-after-school child care; and creating 2 a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that school-age 5 children need the opportunity to attend a quality, developmentally 6 appropriate before-and-after-school care program. The cost of before-7 and-after-school programs creates financial hardships for many families and often results in children being left alone at home. A structured 8 before-and-after-school program can ensure the safety and welfare of 9 10 school-age children. The office of the superintendent of public 11 instruction, the department of social and health services, and the 12 child coordinating committee shall develop care а plan for implementation of a before-and-after-school child care program. 13 The 14 plan shall be submitted to the legislature by December 1, 1992.
