## SENATE BILL 6268

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1992 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to state employee safety at eastern and western 2 state hospitals; creating a new section; and making an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The department of labor and industries 5 shall conduct a study to investigate the problems and causes associated б with the increasing number of assaults on state employees who work at 7 eastern and western state hospitals. The study will include, but not be limited to, the possible ameliorative actions of increased staffing 8 9 levels, increased employee training, physical plant improvements, 10 stronger assault statutes, or other criminal justice initiatives. In 11 their study the department shall consult with state employees and their representatives; department of social and health services and hospital 12 management; advocates of the mentally ill; officials of the state's 13 14 criminal justice including local law enforcement system, and

1 prosecutors; and others with an interest in this issue. The department 2 shall report back to the legislature regarding its findings and 3 recommendations by December 31, 1993.

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. The sum of two hundred fifty thousand 5 dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for 6 the biennium ending June 30, 1993, from the general fund to the 7 department of labor and industries for the purpose of this act.

8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. If any provision of this act or its 9 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 10 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 11 persons or circumstances is not affected.
