- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 75.12.390 and 1989 c 172 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Commercial bottom trawling for food fish and shellfish is unlawful
- 7 in all ((areas of Hood Canal south of a line projected from Tala Point
- 8 to Foulweather Bluff and in Puget Sound south of a line projected from
- 9 Foulweather Bluff to Double Bluff and including)) marine waters east of
- 10 <u>a line projected from Neah Bay north to the International Boundary,</u>
- 11 including all areas of the Straits of Juan de Fuca, Hood Canal, the
- 12 Straits of Georgia, Admiralty Inlet, Puget Sound, all waters
- 13 <u>surrounding the San Juan Islands</u>, and all marine waters east of Whidbey
- 14 Island and Camano Island.
