- 1 AN ACT Relating to a study of pedestrians and bicycle facilities;
- 2 and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The department of transportation shall
- 5 undertake a study, including a cost-benefit analysis, of developing
- 6 pedestrian and bicycle facilities along the state route 520 corridor
- 7 from the vicinity of the University of Washington to the Redmond
- 8 vicinity. In conducting this study, the department shall include
- 9 comment from interested groups, including major employers in the
- 10 region, and shall coordinate its efforts with affected local
- 11 jurisdictions, including the cities of Seattle, Redmond, and Bellevue,
- 12 the University of Washington, and King county. The study shall examine
- 13 and make recommendations regarding the feasibility of imposing tolls or
- 14 other user fees on bicyclists and pedestrians to help compensate for

- 1 the cost of a bridge facility dedicated to nonmotor uses. The
- 2 department shall report its findings to the legislative transportation
- 3 committee by December 1, 1992.
