- 1 AN ACT Relating to state lease of Hanford reservation land;
- 2 amending RCW 43.31.205; adding a new section to chapter 43.31 RCW;
- 3 creating a new section; and making an appropriation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the ninety-
- 6 nine-year lease of one thousand acres of land by the state from the
- 7 federal government requires that the state use any rent moneys from
- 8 subleasing the land to promote the site. The legislature further finds
- 9 that the state agencies charged with administering the lease have
- 10 neglected to undertake this requirement and that the new emphasis on
- 11 waste cleanup at Hanford and the new technologies needed for
- 12 environmental restoration warrant a renewed effort to promote the one
- 13 thousand acres.

- 1 Sec. 2. RCW 43.31.205 and 1990 c 281 s 2 are each amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- In an effort to enhance the economy of the Tri-Cities area, the
- 4 department of trade and economic development is directed to promote the
- 5 existence of the lease between the state of Washington and the federal
- 6 government executed September 10, 1964, covering one thousand acres of
- 7 land lying within the Hanford reservation near Richland, Washington,
- 8 and the opportunity of subleasing the land to entities for nuclear-
- 9 related industry, in agreement with the terms of the lease. When
- 10 promoting the existence of the lease, the department shall work in
- 11 cooperation with any associate development organizations located in or
- 12 <u>near the Tri-Cities area.</u>
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 43.31 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (1) The Hanford sublease rent account is hereby created in the
- 16 state treasury. Moneys in the account may be spent only after
- 17 appropriation and only for the following purposes:
- 18 (a) To promote the existence of the lease between the state of
- 19 Washington and the federal government executed September 10, 1964,
- 20 covering one thousand acres of land lying within the Hanford
- 21 reservation near Richland, Washington;
- 22 (b) To promote the opportunity of subleasing the land to entities
- 23 for nuclear-related industry, in agreement with the terms of the lease;
- 24 and
- 25 (c) To execute any new sublease agreements that meet the terms of
- 26 the lease.
- 27 (2) Sources for this account shall include:
- 28 (a) Any rent payments from subleases of the site; and
- 29 (b) Other funding from federal, state, and local agencies.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** The sum of forty thousand dollars, or as
- 2 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium
- 3 ending June 30, 1993, from the general fund to the department of trade
- 4 and economic development for the purposes of section 2 of this act.
