

SENATE JOINT MEMORIAL 8004

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

By Senators Metcalf, Conner and Moore.

Read first time January 28, 1991. Referred to Committee on Financial Institutions & Insurance.

1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, Congressman Philip M. Crain of Illinois introduced a
9 measure during the 101st Congress that would have required a complete
10 audit of the Federal Reserve System; and

11 WHEREAS, This measure gained wide support, being sponsored by more
12 than sixty congressional members; and

13 WHEREAS, Although this measure did not gain approval, public and
14 congressional accountability would be promoted by the performance of a
15 complete audit of the Federal Reserve System;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that Congress
2 enact legislation to require a complete audit of the Federal Reserve
3 System.

4 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
5 transmitted to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United
6 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
7 House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
8 Washington.
