- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 7 represent and petition as follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, The United States historically has been a melting pot for
- 9 people from many countries; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Increasing numbers of immigrants will result in an
- 11 increased number of children in our public schools for whom English is
- 12 not their native tongue; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The state of Washington provides bilingual education for
- 14 its public school students; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The cost of bilingual education exceeds the cost of other
- 16 education; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The federal government regulates the number of persons
- 2 immigrating to the United States, impacting the demand for bilingual
- 3 education;
- 4 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the United
- 5 States Congress provide financial assistance to fund the increased
- 6 demand for bilingual education.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 8 transmitted to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United
- 9 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
- 10 House of Representatives, and to each member of Congress from the State
- 11 of Washington.
