1 AN ACT Relating to review of the Washington condominium act; 2 creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A statutory committee is created to:
(1) Review the Washington condominium act, and consider comments
concerning the act;

7 (2) Draft recommended revisions to the act; and

8 (3) Prepare appropriate revisions to the comments to the Washington
9 condominium act. The committee shall consist of the following members:
10 (a) One member each of the majority and minority parties of the
11 senate, appointed by the president of the senate;

(b) One member each of the majority and minority parties of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives; (c) Four members of the Washington condominium act revision
 committee of the Washington state bar association;

3 (d) One member appointed by the Washington land title association;
4 (e) One member appointed by the Washington mortgage bankers
5 association;

6 (f) One member appointed by the Washington association of realtors;
7 (g) One member appointed by the Washington chapter of the community
8 associations institute;

9 (h) One member appointed by the homebuilders association of 10 Washington state;

(i) One member appointed by the Washington association of countyofficials;

(j) One member appointed by the institute for real estate management who has lived in a condominium for at least the last five years prior to the appointment and who has served on a condominium association board; and

17 (k) Two members appointed by the governor.

18 The committee shall report to the senate law and justice committee 19 and the house judiciary committee before March 1, 1992.

20 This section shall expire March 1, 1992.

21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 22 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 23 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take 24 effect immediately.

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
