- 1 AN ACT Relating to Skagit river salmon; and creating new sections.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The director of fisheries shall prepare
- 4 a salmon recovery plan for the Skagit river. The plan shall include
- 5 strategies for employing displaced timber workers to conduct salmon
- 6 restoration and other tasks identified in the plan. The plan shall
- 7 incorporate the best available technology in order to achieve maximum
- 8 restoration of depressed salmon stocks. The plan must encourage the
- 9 restoration of natural spawning areas and natural rearing of salmon but
- 10 must not preclude the development of an active hatchery program.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The director shall present the recovery
- 12 plan to the legislature on or before December 31, 1992. The plan shall
- 13 include funding requirements for salmon hatchery programs and natural
- 14 spawning programs.
