1 AN ACT Relating to Skagit river salmon; and creating new sections.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The director of fisheries shall prepare
4 a salmon recovery plan for the Skagit river. The plan shall include
5 strategies for employing displaced timber workers to conduct salmon
6 restoration and other tasks identified in the plan. The plan shall
7 incorporate the best available technology in order to achieve maximum
8 restoration of depressed salmon stocks. The plan must encourage the
9 restoration of natural spawning areas and natural rearing of salmon but
10 must not preclude the development of an active hatchery program.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The director shall present the recovery
12 plan to the legislature on or before December 31, 1992. The plan shall
13 include funding requirements for salmon hatchery programs and natural
14 spawning programs.
