AN ACT Relating to feeding school children during teachers' work stoppage; creating new sections; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that state school 6 feeding programs are essential to the health and well-being of many 7 children and that continuing these programs during a teachers' work 8 stoppage is in the best interests of the state of Washington.

9 The legislature intends to continue to provide food to eligible 10 children during the teachers' work stoppage, which began on April 18, 11 1991, in forty-six districts throughout the state.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. The superintendent of public instruction 13 may reimburse school districts with state funds for the amount of any 14 unavailable federal share of funds for breakfasts or lunches actually provided to children during the teachers' work stoppage that began
April 18, 1991.

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. The sum of two million dollars, or as 4 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium 5 ending June 30, 1991, from the general fund to the superintendent of 6 public instruction solely for the purpose of section 2 of this act.

7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate 8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 9 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take 10 effect immediately.
