1            AN ACT Relating to administration costs for municipal utilities;  
2 adding a new section to chapter 35.33 RCW; adding a new section to  
3 chapter 35.34 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 35A.33 RCW; and  
4 adding a new section to chapter 35A.34 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 35.33 RCW  
7 to read as follows:

8            Whenever any city or town apportions a percentage of the city  
9 manager's, administrator's, or supervisor's time, or the time of other  
10 management or general government staff, for administration, oversight,  
11 or supervision of a utility operated by the city or town, or to provide  
12 services to the utility, the utility budget may identify such services  
13 and budget for reimbursement of the city's or town's current expense  
14 fund for the value of such services.

1        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 35.34 RCW  
2 to read as follows:

3        Whenever any city or town apportions a percentage of the city  
4 manager's, administrator's, or supervisor's time, or the time of other  
5 management or general government staff, for administration, oversight,  
6 or supervision of a utility operated by the city or town, or to provide  
7 services to the utility, the utility budget may identify such services  
8 and budget for reimbursement of the city's or town's current expense  
9 fund for the value of such services.

10       NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 35A.33 RCW  
11 to read as follows:

12       Whenever any code city apportions a percentage of the city  
13 manager's, administrator's, or supervisor's time, or the time of other  
14 management or general government staff, for administration, oversight,  
15 or supervision of a utility operated by the city, or to provide  
16 services to the utility, the utility budget may identify such services  
17 and budget for reimbursement of the city's current expense fund for the  
18 value of such services.

19       NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 35A.34 RCW  
20 to read as follows:

21       Whenever any code city apportions a percentage of the city  
22 manager's, administrator's, or supervisor's time, or the time of other  
23 management or general government staff, for administration, oversight,  
24 or supervision of a utility operated by the city, or to provide  
25 services to the utility, the utility budget may identify such services  
26 and budget for reimbursement of the city's current expense fund for the  
27 value of such services.
